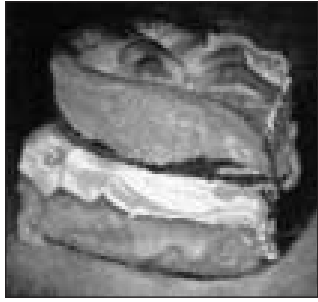

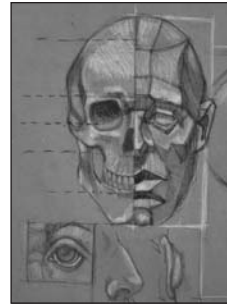

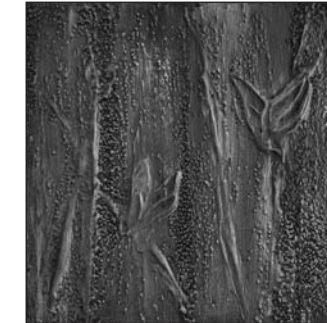
### Acrylic Painting Ages: 5-8

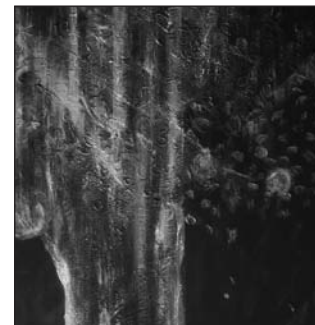
### Watercolor Ages: 5-8

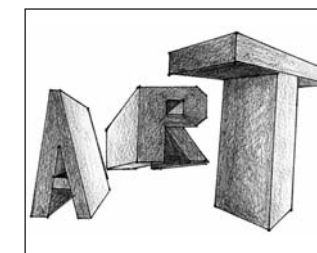
### Acrylic Painting Ages: 8-10
