## Gardens

March 29 - April 29, 2012

Gardens are the star of this juried show. English, vegetable, rock, succulent, Japanese, or a secret garden are just some of the types of gardens that may inspire you. Create your vision of a garden, up close, far away, or the emotion that it evokes.

### Eligibility

- Open to PRAA members only.
- Artwork can be any two or three dimensional media.
- All work must be original in concept and executed by the artist within the last two years.
- Compositions taken from published material or other artist's work or photographs will not be considered original.
- Acceptance into the show will be done with the theme in mind.
- Entries submitted must not have been previously accepted into a PRAA show.

### Sales

- All artwork must be available for sale.
- PRAA will retain a 40% commission on any sales. If any unsold artwork is removed before the end of the show, the 40% commission will be charged to the artist before the artwork is allowed to be removed from the Show.

### Artists Whose Work is Accepted

- Please provide a current biography or artist statement.
- All artists are encouraged to participate in the gallery during the exhibit.

### Awards

- Awards of cash and gift certificates are given to the first three places.

### Presentation

- 2D artwork must be adequately prepared to hang, with screw eyes and wire, and signed by the artist.
- Sculpture and ceramic work must be self-standing or supplied with its own supports.
- Jewelry and other 3D work must be able to be displayed in a case.
- PRAA reserves the right to reject work which is not of reasonable size and weight, is not dry, is deemed unsuitable for the show, or does not meet the criteria described in this prospectus.
- Work with a perimeter larger than 100 inches, including frame, cannot be shown under glass.

### Registration and Delivery

- Any changes to the registration after it has been received by PRAA will require a new entry form and additional fee.
- Work delivered at other than designated hours will not be accepted.
- Artwork and entry form are to be delivered to Studios on the Park, 1130 Pine Street, Paso Robles. **Please use back door** on the Railroad St. side of the building.

### Fees

- There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$10.
- A storage fee of \$5 per day will be charged for work not picked up on time.

### Bin Work:

- Unframed bin work is accepted during this show. Use the same bring in and pick up times. Artists do not need to be in the show to display bin work. See "bin policy" on the website. Bin entries are \$5. Entry forms are available at the Gallery or at PasoRoblesArt.org.
