In Vogue

January 21 - February 21, 2010

This show features art creations dealing with fashion and clothing, or relating to fads and things that are "in style" – from any era. This includes hair styles, tattoos, dresses, hats, scarves, textiles, car dice, whoola-hoops, sunglasses, designer jeans, "woodies", wedding veils, etc.

Eligibility

- Open to PRAA members only.
- Artwork can be any two or three dimensional media.
- All work must be original in concept and executed by the artist within the last two years.
- Compositions taken from published material or other artist's work or photographs will not be considered original.
- Photography is limited to straight photographs through digital software or darkroom processes.
- Acceptance into the show will be done with the theme in mind.

Sales

- All artwork must be available for sale.
- PRAA will retain a 40% commission on any sales. If any unsold artwork is removed before the end of the show, the 40% commission will be charged to the artist before the artwork is allowed to be removed from the Show.

Artists Whose Work is Accepted

- Please provide a current biography, resume, or artist statement for inclusion in "The Parts Catalog", which will be available to the docents and to the public. This information can be updated as frequently as you wish.
- Artists in the show are expected to help staff the gallery during the show for a total of four hours.

Calendar

- Tue, Jan 19 (9-noon) Bring in entries for judging
- Tue, Jan 19 (pm) Notification via email or phone
- Wed, Jan 20 (9-11) Pick up non-accepted work
- Thur, Jan 21 (4-6) Show Opens / Artists reception & awards
- Tue, Feb 23 (9-noon) Pick up work

Awards

- Awards are given to the first three places.
- First place is awarded \$100. Second and third places are awarded cash and gift certificates from neighboring merchants.

Presentation

- 2D artwork must be adequately prepared to hang, with screw eyes and wire, and signed by the artist.
- Sculpture and ceramic work must be self-standing or supplied with its own supports.
- Jewelry and other 3D work must be able to be displayed in a case.
- PRAA reserves the right to reject work which is not of reasonable size and weight, is not dry, is deemed unsuitable for the show, or does not meet the criteria described in this prospectus.

Registration and Delivery

- Any changes to the registration after it has been received by PRAA will require a new entry form and additional fee.
- Work delivered at other than designated hours will not be accepted.
- Artwork and entry form are to be delivered to Studios on the Park, 1130 Pine Street, Paso Robles. **Please use back door** on the Railroad St. side of the building.

Fees

- There is a non-refundable entry fee of \$5.
- A storage fee of \$5 per day will be charged for work not picked up on time.

Bin Work:

- Unframed bin work may be brought in & picked up on the same days as the show. Artists do not need to be in the show to display bin work. See "bin policy" on the website.
